

PRACTICUM INITIATION AND PRACTICUM

Practicum Initiation (COREHS 7097) and Practicum (COREHS 7099) comprise a course sequence. This sequence may span no more than one year. **Students register for Practicum Initiation only once**, using the catalog number and the class number assigned to each course (see course listing). Students register for this 1-credit course upon obtaining approval from their faculty advisor. Practicum Initiation is a non-graded course and is posted to the student's transcript as NG. Practicum is a pass/fail (P/F) course and is posted to the student's transcript upon completion as a pass or fail (P/F). Upon completion of the Practicum, the instructor forwards the final grade for the practicum to the University Registrar. The student has thereby completed the sequence and the final grade (P/F) and the one credit earned are posted to the student's academic record as **Practicum**.

If necessary, while working on the practicum in subsequent semesters, students not registering for other courses must do maintenance of matriculation to maintain active status. This entitles them to have access to the library, other college facilities, and services.
