



Tuition will be payable in two installments. A pre-defined refund schedule will return a portion of the tuition to students who are dismissed from the program for academic reasons or who leave voluntarily according to established procedures. Students who receive federal student aid are subject to both the general New York Medical College refund policy and a separate [Federal Title IV Funds Refund Policy](#).

Special consideration

The refund schedule applies to students who withdraw from the Accelerated BMS program completely. Students who withdraw only from Medical Histology but wish to continue in Biomedical Ethics and Mammalian Physiology I can request a transfer to the evening M.S. in Physiology program. Following review and approval by the admission committee, they may pick up BCHM 1010 if they make this transition early enough during the Fall evening semester. For these students, the "refund" listed above is reduced by the tuition for the Biomedical Ethics and Mammalian Physiology I course (currently \$12,079) and the evening course selected (\$1,236 per credit, up to \$4,944 for 4 credits). Thus, depending upon when the student makes the transfer to the evening program, there might be an additional tuition charge.

Students whose request to transfer to the M.S. in Physiology program during the Spring semester (Block #2 or Block #3) is approved will receive no tuition credit beyond the refund specified in refund schedule and will be responsible for payment of the full tuition for whatever evening courses they register for.
