POLICY: PROGRESSION IN THE CLINICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES PROGRAM

Students are expected to adhere to the New York Medical College Policy for [Satisfactory Academic Progress \(SAP\) Policy](#).

SAP: Refers to the standards that students must meet to maintain their financial aid eligibility and cumulative GPA.

Progression in the Clinical Laboratory Sciences Program is according to an academic timeline, [GSBMS Clinical Laboratory Sciences Calendar](#).

Successful completion of the Program

Students must pass all courses in the program (41.5 credits) with a GPA of 3.0 including an M.S. Literature Review or Capstone Clinical Research Project to be eligible for graduation.

- Passing grade, overall, and of specific components of the Introduction to Clinical Laboratory Sciences course is required to begin Clinical Practicum.
- Overall GPA of less than 3.0 during or at completion of program coursework requires repeat of required courses sufficient to raise GPA to acceptable level.
- Failing grade in a didactic course (offered once a year) must be repeated in following year.
- Failure of a rotation within a Clinical Practicum requires rotation repeat within same semester, if possible.
- Failure of entire Clinical Practicum course requires course to be repeated following semester.

Once a course is repeated and passed, the initial failing grade is excluded from consideration in the qualitative measure of SAP.
